


Do you Want to Pay a Toll to Drive in Greenwich?



Under proposals from Greenwich Council and Transport for London (TfL), a Congestion Charge Tax just like the one in central London could be imposed on Greenwich. You could be paying £6 or even more just to drive through Greenwich town centre, along the A2 or via the Blackwall Tunnel!

Proposed Greenwich Congestion Charge Do you really want to pay extra to drive in Greenwich?



Transport for London and Greenwich council are suggesting that a congestion charge tax be introduced to reduce road traffic in Greenwich. This would not just apply to Greenwich town centre but may also include the Blackwall Tunnel and the A2 so a large area of the London Borough of Greenwich would be covered.

The Association of British Drivers (ABD) is opposed to all forms of road tolls. Drivers are taxed enough already without adding to your bills, and this tax would hit the less wealthy harder than most.

There is no justification for this proposal on environmental grounds. It is just another attack by those who hate the freedom to travel when and where you want that individual car ownership gives you.

We urge you to object to these proposals. But we need to ensure that instead of the informal consultation process that the council is pursuing, that you get a real vote on this issue.
